is honored to be part of a bold ecumenical project being undertaken by several pro-life groups in Sioux Falls. We hope to have a group of people praying at the Planned Parenthood Abortion Facility every single day, connecting the Life Chain each year with the one the following year.

Here's How It Works:

Groups who commit to participating in "The Link" come on their assigned day and spend about a half hour simply praying a rosary in front of the Planned Parenthood facility. They come rain or shine, weekend or weekday, hot or cold, holiday or holy day.

The time is meant to be peaceful and prayerful. Holding signs and marching is discouraged during these prayer meetings. The idea is to be a visible prayer warrior for the lives of unborn babies and to pray for the conversion of those inside the facility.

St. Michael parishioners are committed to three days each month, the 1st, the 10th, and the 15th. We meet at noon. If one of these times does not work for you, please contact the Respect Life Office for other dates and times at 988-3755.

When you sign up, you will receive instructions about parking, etc.

Over the years, several abortion facilities have closed because of prayer vigils. We believe the same thing can happen here. Can you give up part of your lunch hour once a month to help make it happen?
