Taking His Name Thoughts by Father Andy

Third Sunday of Lent



In today's first reading, we find the giving of the Ten Commandments.

These moral laws are probably familiar to most of us. But there's at least one commandment that I believe is vastly misunderstood:

"You shall not take the name of the LORD, your God, in vain."

Many read this as a simple command not to use God's name as a swear word, but it is so much more. Now, don't get me wrong, it is absolutely a sin to cuss using God's name. When I stub my toe, that's an ugly experience and so I reach for an "ugly" word (you know the ones I'm talking about). But to treat God's name as if it belongs in the same category as those ugly words is a profound insult to the God who loves us. However, the second commandment is interested in something much deeper.

First of all, note that it never says, 'You shall not say the name of the Lord in vain.' Rather we find the word take, in Hebrew, nasa (נָשָׂא). This word usually refers to taking an object. It means to lift or carry or bear something. When it's used in the context of a name, it implies a relationship. We see this reflected in English when a wife 'takes' her husband's name. If a wife were to take her husband's name, but continue to act as if she were single, she would be taking his name in vain.

Well, we all call ourselves Christ-ians. We have quite literally taken His name and made it ours. And now the only question is: have I done this in the vain, or do I act like a follower of Christ? One last thing, in the book of Revelation we hear that the saved, "will see Him face to face, and bear His name on their foreheads." Let's pray that we may bear His name for the world to see and one day in the world to come.
