FAITH

FEAR by Rhonda Kelsey

After the Resurrection we hear about the disciples and their fear- "The doors were locked where the disciples were for fear of..." But, I love what came next-JESUS! Jesus stood in their midst and the first thing He said was "Peace be with you". He said this not once, but three times in that Gospel reading. He repeated it so that they would understand, the peace He wanted to give was of eternal value!

This week we hear the disciples were startled, terrified, and troubled by His words "Peace be with you" after the Resurrection. In St. Augustine's writings, he says it was too hard to believe that it was true, "it was incredible, and they had to be persuaded of the truth of it, not only by their eyes but by their hands too, so that through the bodily senses faith might come down into the heart, and this faith coming down into the heart might be preached throughout the world, to people who never saw nor touched, and yet believed."

The English word <u>"church"</u> comes from the Greek word <u>"ekklesia</u>," which means <u>"a gathering"</u> or literally <u>"called-out-ones"</u>. We the Church, we the people of Our Lady of Victory Pastorate, we who neither saw nor touched, yet believed are called out! We are once again living in a time of Apostolic Mission! We are called out to live differently because of THE ONE who "called us out"! We as Christians are to be set apart for the mission of Christ and His church!

One of the things I have read that young people have said about leaving the church is that "the faith or church"; is nothing more than something we sometimes did on Sundays. They are longing for something real because that is the way God made us! They are wanting actual spiritual truth but not finding it. As Fr. Andy would say, "WHAT?"!

If we want the culture to stop winning over our kids **we have to speak boldly and live boldly empowered by the Holy Spirit that we have been given!** It may mean we have to prioritize things differently, back to the way it was meant to be, with Christ at the center of it all.

What else can we learn from the readings during the Easter Season readings? We can learn that HE did not leave us alone to do the hard by ourselves! In the Acts of the Apostle readings, we find people who were doing the hard by being led by the Holy Spirit! They were actively listening and acting in accord with the Holy Spirit! You want to know how I know when the Lord is calling me to do something- it is when my first reaction is "Oh, no, not me, not that Lord!"

As we continue our journey through the Easter Season towards Pentecost let's ask the Lord, what is He calling us to do. Is it to change? If your first response to His request is "Oh no, not me, not that", be not afraid, live in His peace, and buckle up buttercup!

So after reading this, I hope it inspires you to want to do more for St. Michael. We need YOU! We need more help at the Masses. Mass attendance has been slowly increasing--which WE LOVE! 
