PARISH STATISTICS

In 2018-2019 we celebrated the spiritual birth of 87 babies in baptism and 6 adults in the ceremony of reception. We rejoiced when 25 couples began their married life with the Sacrament of Matrimony. With hope of resurrection we gave prayerful and community support to 29 grieving families whose loved ones died in the Lord.

17 adults were Confirmed into the Catholic faith. 59 teens made a lifetime commitment to the Catholic tradition of Christianity with the Sacrament of Confirmation. 55 second graders received Jesus for the first time in the Sacrament of First Communion.

We are a Parish that lives out its mission by serving the People of God. We are nourished by the Bread of Life to go out to others!

- Adults and children prepared and served breakfast and dinner to over 2400 people at the Banquet main location and Banquet West.
- Volunteers shop for groceries, prepare and serve lunch for the Good Shepherd Center twice a month.
- Drivers deliver Meals on Wheels each week.
- A group worked together to package dried food for meals to be distributed by Kids Against Hunger.
- Parishioners donated and delivered countless items for the Adoration Sisters, Food Pantry, and for our Advent Angels Project.
- The St. Vincent DePaul Council assisted hundreds of families in need with rent, utilities, food, support, etc.
- Volunteers work at the St. Vincent store, and distribute diapers to moms in need.
- Qualified drivers bring parishioners to Mass in our van on Saturday.
- Adults share God's gift of faith with our youth grades 1-12 in religious education classes.
- Musicians share their musical gifts to help us pray.
- Caregivers allow mom and dad to attend Mass while the little one is in the nursery!
- Ministers visit the nursing homes and hospitals to share prayer and Eucharist with those who cannot be with us.
- Ministers serve at Mass in many different ways.
- Workers fold and fill the envelopes to make this mailing possible!!!
